Guest Speaker: Charlie Clough

Charlie Clough was the speaker at our very first Labor Day Conference in 1969! He then went on to be a regular speaker for many years.

Charlie was born in Brooklyn, NY and grew up on Long Island. Upon graduation from high school, he received a full scholarship to Massachusetts Institute of Technology where he was led to the Lord by a Campus Crusade for Christ member in his first semester. He went on to complete his BS in Math at MIT and also did some graduate work.

After four years in the Air Force as a meteorologist, he entered Dallas Theological Seminary where he earned the ThM in Old Testament Hebrew. Upon graduation in 1968, he began a ministry as pastor of the Lubbock Bible Church (Lubbock, TX) where he served in that capacity for 12 years, and where he developed a unique approach to training believers through a Basic Framework for Christian Doctrine.

In the early 1980's Charlie earned the MS in Atmospheric Science from Texas Tech University, and from 1982 until his retirement in 2006, he was a staff meteorologist with the Dept of Army at Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland. Presently he is working on publishing his Basic Framework series in a properly edited and polished format. Charlie and his wife, Carole, are the parents of four grown sons and make their home in Bel Air Maryland.
